# RECYCLABLES Blue transparent bag.

#### Metals

Aerosol Cans (empty) Aluminum (pie plates, foil, etc.) Bottles and Cans (steel, tin and aluminum) Containers

Small metal household items

## Tips & **Tricks**

Pizza Boxes - Remove any crusts or leftover cheese and place the box in the Recyclables and the paper in the Garbage.

Food Containers - Empty and quickly rinse metal and plastic containers with cold water; it only takes a second or two. As long as nothing will leak, drip or spill out onto the rest of your recyclables, it's clean enough for us! Aluminum - Scrape off excess food and fold or crumple the dirty side in.

#### **Plastics**

**Bottles** Containers **Cups and Dishes** Hard Plastic Packaging Jugs

Medicine Bottles (empty) Bubble Wrap



Plastic Bags (clean and dry) Grocery and other plastic shopping bags, bread bags, clean re-sealable food storage bags, etc. To prevent mechanical sorting equipment from getting entangled, put all plastic bags in a single bag and tie it.

#### Other Items

Small electronics (calculators, bathroom appliances, small kitchen appliances, etc.)

Cell phones (only in blue bag if you can remove the batteries first)

Frozen Juice Cans Lids, Covers Styrofoam (meat trays, cups, plates, packaging, etc.)

**Food and Beverage Cartons** (milk, juice, broth, plant based beverages, etc.)

# **ORGANICS** Green or certified compostable transparent bag.

#### Food

Expired Food (no packaging) Fish and Shellfish Food Scraps and Leftovers

Rotten or Moldy Food

## Yard Waste

**Grass Clippings Wood Chips** 

Branches - 1 inch (2.54cm) diameter or less, bundled in 2'x2'x2' (0.6x0.6x0.6m) bundles.

Compostable Transparent Bags - You can use these bags if certified under ASTM D 6400 or CAN/BNQ 0017-088 and have both of the following logos visible on the bags:





Orange and Paper Bags - Although we prefer green Organics bags, orange and paper bags can be used for leaves and yard waste only.

## Tips & **Tricks**

Diapers and Pet Waste - They are preferred in the clear Garbage bag, but may go in the Organics bag on weeks Garbage is not Ropes, Cables, Wire - To prevent mechanical sorting equipment from becoming entangled and breaking, always place these

items in the Garbage.

Soft Plastic - Any soiled plastic film, cereal or cracker bags, chip and snack bags, plastic packaging, plastic wrap, cheese and sandwich meat packaging, belong in the Garbage.

Never put these items in your regular household waste; bring them to our Mobile Eco-Depot, Solid Waste Facility, or visit our website for other disposal details.
